When planning a mission trip for your church, your time should be spent making an impact, not frustratingly trying to fill fundraising gaps for your team.

Too many churches waste countless hours organizing big fundraisers and trying to orchestrate opportunities for trip-goers to gain the money they need to go on their next missions experience. However, the more time churches spend striving to attain donations, the less time they spend preparing their mission teams for their trips ahead. What is Social Fundraising?

The online world has seen a major shift. Over the past decade, internet communication has gone from broad, generalized headlines to taking a significantly more personal approach. Why? Digital natives are disinterested in receiving messaging that doesn't appear genuine.

As a result, we have all discovered that we'd rather feel like we're talking to a person than reading an automated message. Think about it. How many generic, sales-pitch-like titled emails have you deleted without opening them? At least hundreds, right? Let's face it, we don't want to talk to computers. We want to connect with people.

This is why social fundraising for mission trips works.

Social fundraising is a strategy that empowers trip-goers to share their personal excitement, passion and perspective about their upcoming trip and ask close connections for support. This goes above and beyond corporate or congregational fundraising events asking for checks to individuals with social media platforms sharing their personal funding URLs. The pressure is less on the team leaders and more on the team members. And, it's better that way.

When friends or family members see a loved one involved in a mission trip, they get to connect with the experience and engage in the process through online sharing and storytelling. Giving links make it easy for people to donate and more likely to share what their friend or family member is up to on their own platform, exposing more and more people to the opportunity to support.

Peer-to-peer fundraising is the most effective strategy for church mission trip attendees because trip-goers who create their own web pages and social media campaigns are more likely to get fully funded. An individual can share their specific trip page (which usually includes pictures, a personal story and the percent funded) with friends, family members and followers who then get to truly connect with all God is doing through the individual, church, group, and mission.

People want to support people and social fundraising allows them that opportunity.



How to Use Social Fundraising for Your Church's Next Mission Trip

Mission trip technology systems can be used to automate the management of your mission trips, vacation bible schools, ministries, and events with custom workflows. These programs can also be used to oversee:

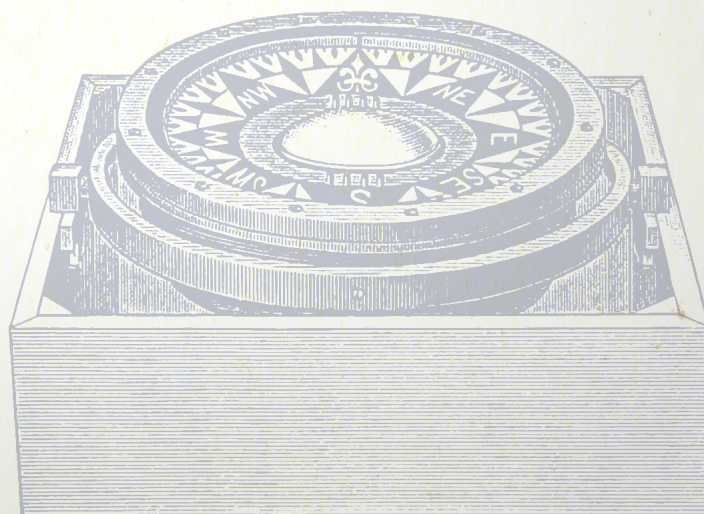
- **Custom applications, requirements and checklists**

The social fundraising process begins in a mission trip technology system when an applicant is approved to go onto the trip and becomes a participant. If the trip-goer is responsible for their funding (or social fundraising), then they receive a personalized trip URL to promote and share on their social media pages. On this page, the participant has the ability to:

- **Upload an image for the trip**
- **Share their funding goal**
- **Add a participant story**
- **Share the dates of the trip**
- **Share their percent funded**
- **Direct potential supporters toward the action button to easily and securely donate.**

After making a gift of any amount, a donor receives an email stating the information about their tax deductible gift. The trip participant also receives a notification that a gift was made so they can respond by thanking their donors.

Mission trip management software is an incredible asset for churches because it integrates with other ChMS systems like Realm and MinistryPlatform. When donations for mission trips are posted in the ChMS, they can be seen by the donor on their record and become a part of their giving statements.

Participant benefits:

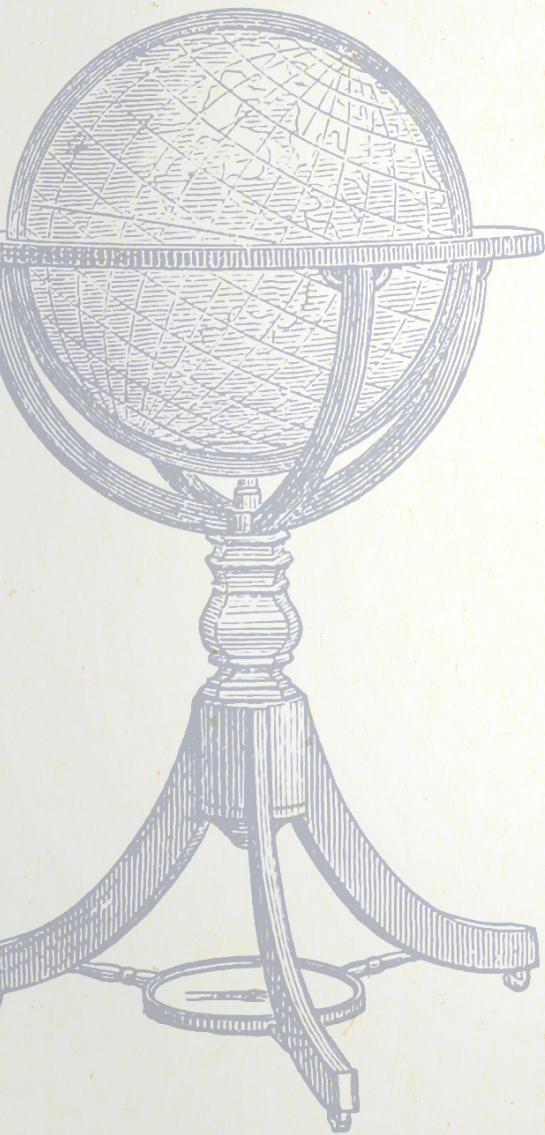
When social fundraising, trip-goers can easily access and share information about their funding status while building a community of donors who are also invested in prayer and spiritual support throughout the fundraising process. This strategy is a very effective and easy way to attain financial and personal support.

Donor benefits:

Social fundraising allows for donors to give directly to a particular person going on a specific trip. After donating, their gift goes directly to the church and is updated automatically through the mission trip management software in all the correct giving documents. They are also able to come back to the fundraising page to see updates, learn about the trip after the participant returns home, and follow their missionary's spiritual growth through the process.

Church benefits:

No more paper tracking and wondering what money goes where. Social fundraising eliminates confusion by leaving an electronic audit trail.
